Background	The Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre Alliance (VCCC Alliance) is a collective impact organisation working with a common agenda to improve outcomes for people affected by cancer.
	We will be launching a national patient-partnered cancer research program which aims to partner directly with cancer patients across Australia.
	The program will provide an opportunity for patients to share their clinical data, biospecimens (for genomics) and their cancer experiences with researchers globally.
	Our intention is to create a multinational dataset with the power to unlock better diagnostic techniques, treatments, and long-term outcomes.
	We want cancer patients to be active partners in this program, both in its design, and its implementation. To achieve this, a Patient Advisory Committee (PAC) will be established. The committee will be tasked with making initial and ongoing recommendations to the Program Director for improvements and innovations that can maximise impact of patient-related activities.
	The VCCC Alliance is actively seeking applications from cancer consumers to form the PAC. A cancer consumer, defined as a past, present, or potential user of a cancer service. A person affected by cancer includes patient, a person caring for someone with cancer, or a family member or friend. Membership will strive for representation from all Australian states and territories.
Accountability To	The PAC will report to the Patient-Partnered Cancer Research Joint Steering Committee via the Program Director and VCCC Alliance Executive Director.
Main Purpose of Position	The PAC will provide strategic advice and direction from the patient perspective to maximise study success and research outcomes. Areas for strategic advice include patient engagement, recruitment, and retention of study participants. Committee members will also act as champions for the program.
Key Effectiveness Areas	 Provide experience, guidance, and priorities from the patient perspective Advocate for the patient perspective to be integrated across the research program to embed patient-centredness as a core value. Provide oversight and strategic advice on continuous improvement of patient activities and evaluation in a timely manner. Make recommendations and provide input to the Scientific Innovation and Advisory Committee and Equity Advisory Committee. Act as ambassadors for the program in each state, and nationally, to promote the importance and value of the program to patients, and other key stakeholders Foster networking, information sharing, two-way communications, and collaboration with patient advocacy organisations and community groups Attendance and proactive participation in quarterly meetings and respond to reasonable out-of-session requests. Work respectfully and inclusively within the committee and broader patient community.
