Position Title	VCCC Alliance Patient Advisory Committee Chair
Background	The Victorian Comprehensive Cancer Centre Alliance (VCCC Alliance) is a collective impact organisation working with a common agenda to improve outcomes for people affected by cancer.
	We will be launching a national patient-partnered cancer research program which aims to partner directly with cancer patients across Australia.
	The program will provide an opportunity for patients to share their clinical data, biospecimens (for genomics) and their cancer experiences with researchers globally.
	Our intention is to create a multinational dataset with the power to unlock better diagnostic techniques, treatments, and long-term outcomes.
	We want cancer patients to be active partners in this program, both in its design, and its implementation. To achieve this, a Patient Advisory Committee (PAC) will be established. The committee will be tasked with making initial and ongoing recommendations to the Program Director for improvements and innovations that can maximise impact of patient-related activities.
	The VCCC Alliance is actively seeking applications for a highly motivated cancer consumer to Chair the PAC meetings.
	A cancer consumer, defined as a past, present, or potential user of a cancer service. A person affected by cancer includes patient, a person caring for someone with cancer, or a family member or friend.
Accountability To	The PAC Chair will report directly to the Patient-Partnered Cancer Research Program Director and the VCCC Alliance Executive Director.
Main Purpose of Position	The PAC Chair will oversee the strategic direction of the PAC.
	The primary aim of the Chair is to create a cohesive committee and ensure the expertise of the lived experience is incorporated in program design and delivery.
	The Chair will provide regular advice, and recommendations from the PAC to the Patient-Partnered Cancer Research Program Director and the VCCC Alliance Executive Director.
	The successful incumbent will also build collaboration networks and support effective patient-related program activities across Australia.

Remuneration	PAC Chair will be offered remuneration for their time. Remuneration will be offered in accordance with the VCCC Alliance Accounting and Financial Management Policy and related procedures.
