- The multidisciplinary professions across the teletrial industry.

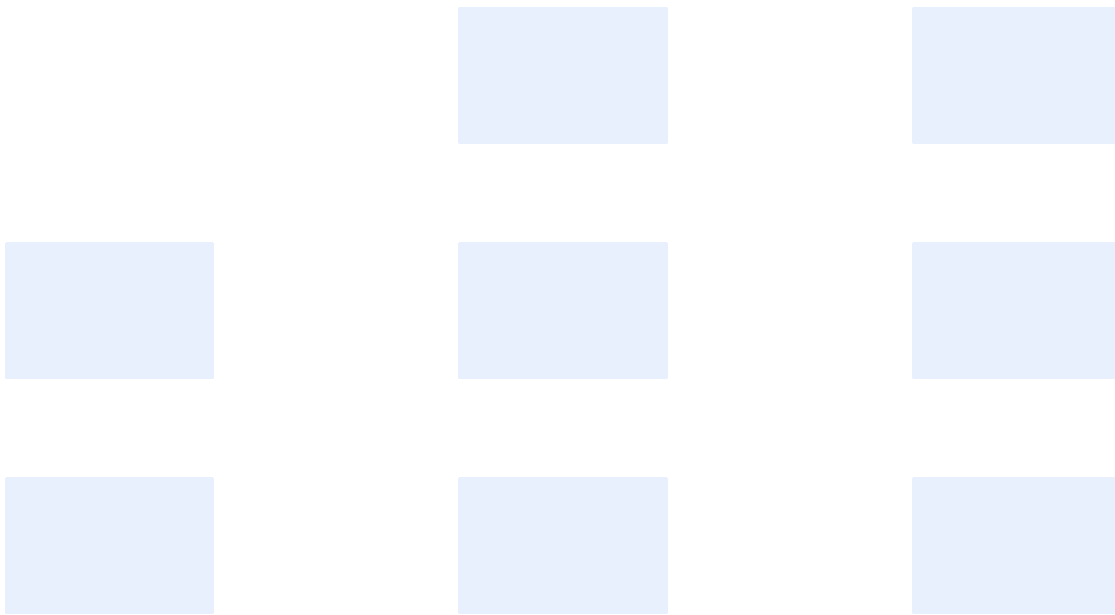
